

Work Program & Activities

Academic Activities

EU Certificate Program

The Undergraduate and Graduate Certificate in European Union Studies will be an initiative of the EU Center. Both interdisciplinary and international in its orientation, the Undergraduate and Graduate Certificate program will provide a Bachelor of Arts (or Science) and MA degree at PNU with the opportunity to combine relevant experiences on a study abroad.

Research Fellow Program

The PNU EU Center will offer Faculty Research Fellowship Program, Course Development Grants, and Graduate Student Area Studies and Foreign Language Fellowship in European Union Studies.

MA and Ph.D. degree course in EU studies

PNU EU Center opens MA and Ph.D degree course in EU studies at PNU Graduate School of International Studies for the first time in Korea. EU studies major aims at training EU experts who have overall Europe region commercial knowledge and valuable on-the-job experiences by offering scholarship, short and long term training programs and EU enterprise internship programs. The course will consist of classes such as Europe Economic Integration, Europe Trade Policies, and Europe International Relations. The course will be started from spring semester 2010.

Lecture and Seminar Series

The PNU EU Center will bring EU academics, practitioners and experts to Korea to provide teaching, lectures and seminar in the PNU EU Center. They mainly will give a public lecture to the PNU and local communities and will also take part in visits with students, business people, local leaders and other groups to raise public understanding of many complex issues facing Europe today.





Outreach Activities

EU University Summer Program

Students in PNU will be encouraged to go to Europe for taking Summer School offered by European universities. Students will have a chance to experience the EU system firsthand, through presentations by specialists, visits to EU institutions. PNU EU Center bestows scholarships to students and fellows.

EU Fair

The PNU EU center will have EU Fair in other countries to make students learn about the regional integrations, and to make EU companies widely understand the business and investment opportunities in Busan. EU Fair will promote closer relations between the municipal authorities of Busan and EU officials and companies. The program is made up of lectures and workshops.

Forum and International Conferences

With the collaboration of the European Commission, SNU-KIEP, KSCES, BDI, UDI, EUCCK, EU member countries' cultural centers and, if necessary, with Busan Ilbo and Busan MBC, workshops and international conferences will be organized to increase the awareness of students and public regarding EU related issues.

Europe Business Meeting This outreach activity will be designed to target local business and economic research institutes in Busan. The Center will arrange the meeting between European business men (or practitioners), local business men and researchers.

Expert Panel Meeting

The PNU EU Center will organize a short term expert panel and training meeting composed of a group of local politician, decision makers and opinion leaders each year in close cooperation with Brussels.







Joint Research Program The primary mission of the Co-Research Program of EU and Korean scholars is to research together, communicate concerns, issues, requests, etc. from the PNU EU center faculty members. More broadly, this vehicle for Korea-EU faculty co-research, communication and interaction aims to foster a stronger research community within worldwide EU centers not only in EU but also USA or any other country. As one of the academic exchanges, the professors and specialists in EU and PNU could have more experienced and useful outcomes from their co-research program. From the different perspective on EU, it can make a harmonized and developed research and help them understand EU fully.

This program's objective is to bring EU scholars to Busan to teach on EU related issues and prepare them to contact related Pusan National University and other related Korean institutions. This will create a fellowship program for specialists of EU affairs with a view to tutoring Korean academics and students in EU related disciplines.

The programs were on the functions of the EU system and topics related to Europe.

On July, 2 students were sent to College of Europe in Belgium for a week, 7 students to Warsaw School of Economics in Poland for 16 days. On August, 2 students to Katholieke Universiteit Leuven in Belgium for 12 days and 15 students to University of Limerick in Ireland for a week.

The interdisciplinary programs provided students a variety of benefits including a chance to experience and to understand the system, society, culture, politics, economics and the process of integration of EU.
